# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

#### WHEREAS -

### 1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU:

1.1. This MOU shall establish the criteria under which Coloplast, and UPUMS, Saifai shall carry out joint collaborative activities to initiate 'Care Clinic' (hereinafter referred to as "PROJECT").

#### 2. SCOPE OF THE PROJECT:

## 3. Roles and Responsibilities of Coloplast

- 3.5. Coloplast to provide dedicated team to focus on this project and its successful execution
- 3.6. Coloplast shall arrange brochures, posters, booklets, branding signages and other patient educational material for the Care Clinic and provide marketing support to promote the benefits of the Care Clinic to the hospital patients

# 4. Roles and Responsibilities of UPUMS, Saifai

- 4.1. The hospital shall provide dedicated space in the premises to run the Care Clinic
- 4.2. The hospital shall allocate nurses/staff to manage the clinic.
- 4.3. The hospital shall partner with Coloplast Academy to conduct educational activities at the Care Clinic.
- 4.4. As a Knowledge Partner, the hospital shall allow Coloplast Academy logo on all patient educational material and in clinic branding.

#### 5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SAFEGUARDS:

- 5.1. All educational materials and trademarks are proprietary of Coloplast and shall not be distributed / shared with any third party without the consent of Coloplast.
- Coloplast may stipulate for a Non-Disclosure Agreement to be signed prior to providing Coloplast registered material.


